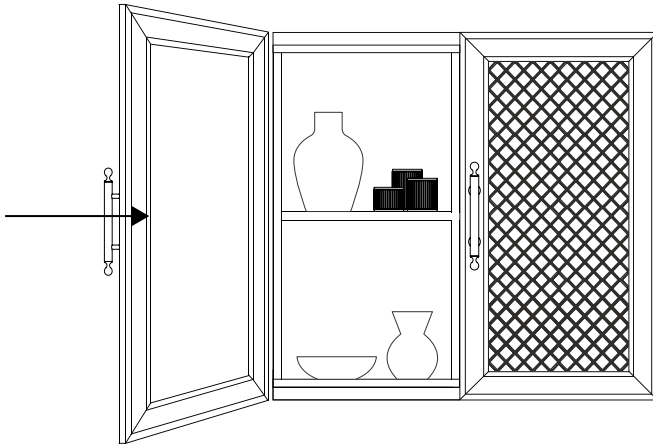


How to install *Grilles*

This guide provides an overview of the most common installation method used for decorative grilles. Covering panel recessing, grille positioning, and securing with wooden beading, this guide is designed to help achieve a secure fit and a neat, professional finish.

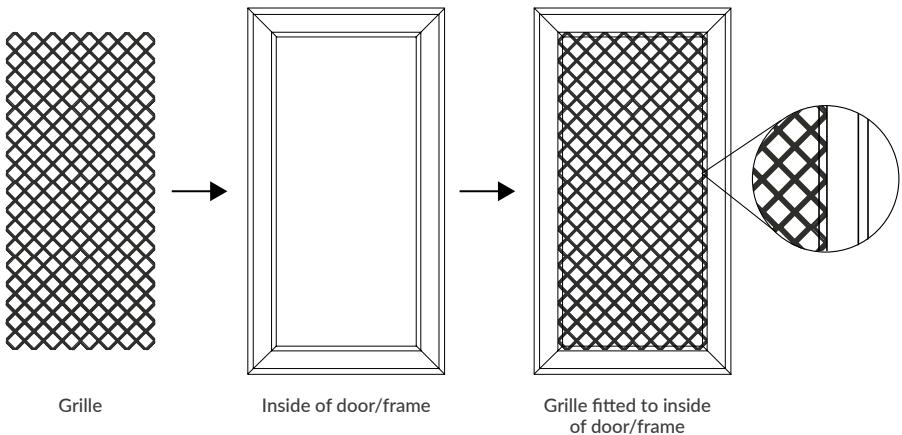
1. Recessing the Panel:

The rear of the panel should first be recessed to create a shallow opening for the grille to sit within. This allows the grille to fit securely while sitting neatly and flush within the panel surface.



2. Positioning the Grille:

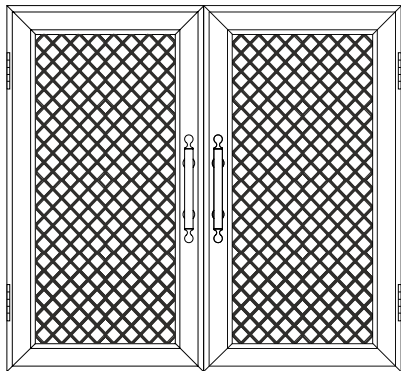
Once the recess has been prepared, position the grille within the recessed area. This helps ensure the grille sits securely in place and is aligned correctly within the panel.



3. Securing with Wooden Beading:

Once the grille has been positioned correctly, secure it in place using wooden beading around the perimeter of the panel. The beading helps hold the grille firmly against the recessed area while creating a neat and professional finish.

This installation method ensures the grille is mounted securely and appears seamless from the front of the panel.
